There is a separate timetable/matrix for all clubs for this half term.

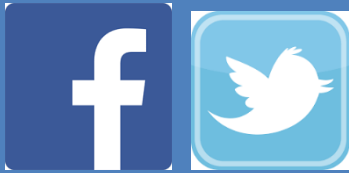
We had some huge successes in both sport and music last year and we are looking forward to building on them this year.
